

Connecting to 'fsustudent' or 'fsuemployee' Wireless Networks from Mac OS X

Step 1: Click on your airport icon on the menu bar (near the top right of the screen). This will present a list of available wireless networks similar to figure A.

Step 2: Select the wireless network you want to connect to, either fsustudent or fsuemployee.

Step 3: A screen with username/password fields will present itself; it should look similar to figure B.

Step 4: Enter your Frostburg credentials including the "@frostburg.edu" part of your username. It is recommended NOT to check the "remember password in keychain". Click Okay to connect.

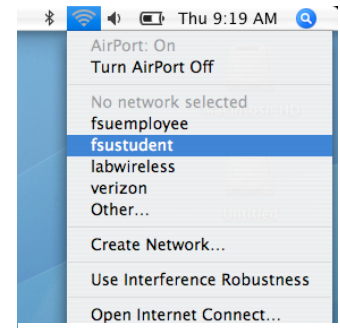

Step 5: After clicking Okay, you will be presented with a dialog requesting you to accept a certificate. This dialog will be similar to exhibit C. You should always verify certificates are from a trusted source, clicking "show certificate" will allow you to see its from the fsustudent/fsuemployee network. You want to click continue.

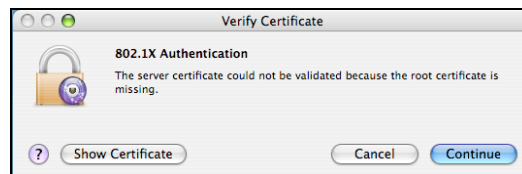

Note: After your first connection you will be presented with a slightly different login screen when attempting to connect to the wireless network. This login screen will be similar to exhibit D.

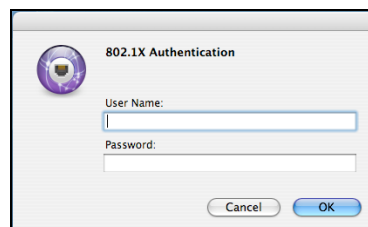
