___ 4. C or above in ENGL 101/111.
___ 5. Twenty (20) documented hours of working with diverse populations. *
___ 6. Declaration of a major. Transfer students must indicate intended major at transfer institutions.
___ 7. Successful completion of technology inventory. *
___ 8. Certified free of TB.
___ 9. Completion of consent and release form. **
___ 10. C or above in MATH 206.
___ 11. Grade of C or above in EDUC 100.
___ 12. Declaration of specialization.

Phase II Admission Requirements:

- ___ 1. Completion of at least 60 credit hours (Junior standing).
___ 2. Cumulative GPA of a least 2.5 (including final grade point averages from transfer institutions).
___ 3. C or better in each of the Phase I courses designated by program.
___ 4. Cumulative GPA of 2.5 in each of the Phase I courses designated by program.
___ 5. Grade of P in EDUC 200.
___ 6. Grade of C or better in ENGL 308 or equivalent.
___ 7. Completion of at least one course in each of groups A,B,C, and D of the Modes of Inquiry of the GEP.
___ 8. Positive recommendation of advisor.
___ 9. Seventy-five percent or 18 credits of specialization completed with study plan submitted to the Office of Unit Assessment.
___ 10. Grade of C or better in MATH 207.

Admission Requirements for Professional Development Schools

- ___ 1. Successful completion of EDUC 307 (field work).
___ 2. Cumulative GPA of at least 2.5.
___ 3. GPA of 2.5 in major with no grade less than C in Block I courses.
___ 4. Successful completion of a collaborative entrance interview into a PDS. *

Phase III Admission Requirements:

- ___ 1. Completion of at least 90 credit hours (senior standing).
___ 2. Cumulative GPA of at least 2.60.
___ 3. GPA of at least 2.75 in all required education courses.
___ 4. GPA of at least 2.75 in area of specialization.
___ 5. Grade of C or better in each Phase II course.
___ 6. Successful completion of Phase II field work.
___ 7. Approval of Program Coordinator.
___ 8. Verification of taking PRAXIS II content knowledge and pedagogy tests.

Program Exit Requirements

- ___ 1. Successful presentation of a portfolio that meets standards.
