Costs many vary given the type of housing and board plans selected by the student, and the student's enrollment in summer coursework.

Graduate Assistant provide 30 hours tuition remission and \$5,000 cash stipend for an academic year (fall/spring) or the equivalent of \$15,110, so they must show support of \$7,982 in order to cover all expenses. (Summer remission and stipend not included as many GAs are not awarded during summer.)

International Fellowship provides 30 hours tuition remission and \$6,650 cash stipend for an academic year (fall/spring) and \$2,800 cash stipend for summer or the total equivalent of \$20,220, so they must show support of \$2,872 in order to cover all expenses. (Summer remission and stipend are included as all IFs are eligible for award during summer.)
