

Supplemental Application Instructions Master of Science in Counseling Psychology

- Self-statement

All applicants are to provide a typewritten statement (limited to three pages single spaced) in which the following points are addressed.

- Briefly describe yourself, e.g., Where are you from? Whom do you consider to be your family? What are you currently doing with your life in terms of education and/or work? What are your recreational interests? Etc.
- What are your specific life and career goals and aspirations?
- Are there significant life experiences that you have had that were instrumental in your choosing a career in counseling?
- Identify your current strengths and needs for development.
- Describe the typical ways you deal with stress and conflict with others.
- Why did you choose to apply to Frostburg State University's Counseling Psychology program?
- After having read through the materials that describe our program, what, if any, concerns or questions do you have about our program?

Applicants seeking admission to the M.S. in Counseling Psychology degree program are asked to obtain three references (at least two of which must be academic – exceptions must be justified). Please sign each waiver and ask those recommending you to complete the Request for Recommendation form.
