- ELO (Experiential Learning Option)
 - FSU Honors students may use advanced experiences such as internships, study abroad, research, student teaching, student working, etc., for upper-level Honors credit.
 - o Each student can complete up to 2 ELOs.
 - o Process:
 - Before you begin the experience, reach out to the Honors Program and a mentor to begin the proposal process. Fill out a proposal form and submit it to the Honors Program via email or in person.
 - After completing the experience, write a reflection paper that:
 - Is 3-5 pages.
 - Double spaced
 - Discusses your experience and how it benefited you in a scholarly way.
 - When finished, turn in your essay and completion form to the Honors Program via email or in person.
 - Email us at honorsprog@frostburg.edu with any questions, concerns, or to submit proposal/completion forms.
- Honors Thesis
 - Schedule a meeting with the Honors Program director at honorsprog@frostburg.edu to discuss your Honors Thesis proposals.

Enhancements:

- FSU Honors students may "enhance" 2 standard courses for Honors credit. An enhancement is typically an additional paper or project, but the content is ultimately up to the course instructor. These can be especially helpful for students who have a lot of AP credit or have completed the majority of the GEP program.
- Each student can complete up to 2 enhancements.
- Process:
 - During the first few weeks of the semester, the student should ask their instructor if they are able to complete an enhancement. The student and instructor then need to reach a consensus about what the additional assignment should be.
 - The student should then turn in a signed proposal form via email or in person.
 - At the end of the semester, the completion form must be signed and submitted via email or in person.
