

USMx Small Private Online Course (SPOC) Educational Equity and Restorative Practice

Frostburg State University's **College of Education** is offering a three-credit professional development online course through **edX edge** that is designed for teachers and administrators for recertification credit.

The course does not require admission to Frostburg State University. However, you can transfer the SPOC three credits into an existing graduate program of study at Frostburg State University. The course has been approved by MSDE for *three Continuing Professional Development (CPD) credits*.

September 7, 2021 – October 15, 2021

Course Information:

This course is interactive and online with the possibility of synchronous meetings at the end of the course. The modules are provided one week at a time and are self-paced. The course was developed by experts in the field with an USMx instructional designer. The three-credit course will guide you through 5 modules. The modules include: Educational Equity, Disproportionality, & Law; Disrupting Implicit Bias; Multi-tiered System of Supports & Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports; Intro to Restorative Practices; Implementing Restorative Practices.
