Frostburg State University is offering a one credit online course through **edX edge** that is designed for counselors to obtain recertification credit and satisfy MSDE requirement for training on Lauryn's Law.

The course does not require admission to Frostburg State University. However, you can transfer the SPOC credit into an existing program of study at Frostburg State University. The course has been approved by MSDE for *one Continuing Professional Development (CPD) credit*.

Course Information:

This course is interactive and totally online. It was developed by experts in the field with an USMx instructional designer.

The one credit course will guide you through 5 modules. The modules include: Introduction to Suicide Prevention, Risk/Protective Factors, Special Population and Trauma Triggers, Self-Violence and Interventions, Student Engagement and Community Resources. There will be a module each week that will contribute to your professional knowledge and skills in the field.
