



Associate's to Bachelor's (ATB) Option **General Information for this Online Option**

(Option is delivered in a fully online format with no on-campus requirements)

I. General Program Information

This dual enrollment option is available to eligible students once they are accepted to the FCC Nursing Program. Admission is competitive and based on completed courses, grade point average (GPA), and TEAS scores. Students will be enrolled as degree students at FCC and FSU and begin to take FSU online courses during the Nursing Program at FCC. Once the Associate of Science Degree (A.S.) is awarded at FCC, students must take and pass the nursing licensure exam, the NCLEX-RN, and then continue coursework at FSU to complete the Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing (B.S.N.).

Program length is 9 terms, including winter and summer sessions, and it takes approximately 2 ½ years to complete.

FCC courses will be held at FCC's campus; FSU courses will be taken as online courses.

Two degrees will be awarded: A.S. from FCC and B.S.N. from FSU (where a minimum of 30 credits will be required from FSU to graduate).

Advisors will be available from both FCC and FSU.

Financial aid will be arranged through Frostburg State University Office of Financial Aid.

II. Program Admission Requirements

- A. Admission to the FCC Nursing Program
- B. Selective process based on courses completed, GPA, and TEAS score
- C. GPA of 3.0 or higher in FCC required admission courses
- D. Additional required courses (completed by the start of the first nursing course) with a C or better:
 - Chemistry (CHEM 100 or CHEM 101) 4 credits (must include a lab)
 - Statistics (MATH 120 or MATH 127) 3 credits
 - Nutrition (NUTR 102 or NUTR 200) 3 credits

III. ATB Program Progression

Students must remain in FCC's Nursing Program to continue in the ATB Option.

Students are expected to complete the sequence of study as outlined in the FCC - FSU ATB curriculum plan.

Students must successfully pass the NCLEX-RN to complete the remaining FSU courses.

IV. General Application Procedures

Note: Students applying to the FSU ATB Option must first be accepted to the FCC A.S. Degree Nursing Program. Admission to the FSU Option is contingent upon admission to FCC’s Nursing Program.

2. Contact the FSU Department of Nursing, at nursing@frostburg.edu, to **request an application fee waiver code**. When prompted for payment, enter fee waiver code.
3. Have official transcripts from all previously attended colleges/universities sent to FSU Admissions.
4. Admissions will review application and send to the FSU Nursing Department.
5. FCC and FSU Nursing Departments will review for acceptance into the ATB option.
6. Student will be notified by email with admission decision.
