



# Associate's to Bachelor's (ATB) Option General Information for this Online Option

(Option is delivered in a fully online format with no on-campus requirements)

#### **I. General Program Information**

This dual enrollment option is available to eligible students once they are accepted to the HCC Nursing Program. Admission is competitive and based on completed courses and grade point average (GPA). Students will be enrolled as degree students at HCC <u>and</u> FSU and begin to take FSU online courses <u>during</u> the Nursing Program at HCC. Once the Associate of Science Degree (A.S.) is awarded at HCC, students must take and pass the nursing licensure exam, the NCLEX-RN, and then continue coursework at FSU to complete the Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing (B.S.N.).

Program length is 9 terms, including winter and summer sessions, and it takes approximately 2 ½ years complete.

HCC courses will be held at HCC's campus; FSU courses will be taken as online courses.

Two degrees will be awarded: A.S. from HCC and B.S.N. from FSU (where a minimum of 30 credits will be required from FSU to graduate).

Advisors will be available from both HCC and FSU.

Financial aid will be arranged through Frostburg State University Office of Financial Aid.

### **II. Program Admission Requirements**

- A. Admission to the HCC Nursing Program
- B. Completion of all HCC Nursing Program prerequisite courses
- C. Selective process based on courses completed, GPA, and TEAS score
- D. GPA of 3.0 or higher in HCC required admission courses
- E. Additional required courses (completed by the start of the first nursing course) with a C or better:

• Chemistry (CHM-101 or CHM-103) 4 credits (must include a lab)

Statistics (MAT-109)
 Nutrition (HEA-102 or BIO-206)
 3 credits

#### **III. ATB Program Progression**

Students must remain in Hagerstown Community College's Nursing Program to continue in the ATB Option. Students are expected to complete the sequence of study as outlined in the HCC - FSU ATB curriculum plan. Students must successfully pass the NCLEX-RN to complete the remaining FSU courses.

#### **IV. General Application Notes & Procedures**

- Students applying to the FSU ATB Option must also apply to the HCC A.S. Degree Nursing Program.
- Admission to the FSU Option is contingent upon admission to HCC's Nursing Program.

  - 2. Contact the FSU Department of Nursing, at <a href="mailto:nursing@frostburg.edu">nursing@frostburg.edu</a>, to request an application fee waiver code. When prompted for payment, enter fee waiver code.
  - 3. Have official transcripts from all previously attended colleges/universities sent to FSU Admissions.
  - 4. Admissions will review file and send to the FSU Nursing Department.
  - 5. HCC and FSU Nursing Departments will review for acceptance into the ATB option.
  - 6. Student will be notified by email with admission decision.
