



Associate's to Bachelor's (ATB) Option General Information for this <u>Online Option</u>

(Option is delivered in a fully online format with no on-campus requirements)

I. General Program Information

This dual enrollment option is available to eligible students once they successfully complete NUR 1020 and meet with Ms. Nicole Stubbs, Allied Health and Nursing Pathway Advisor/Transfer Advisor at PGCC (Prince George's Community College). Admission is competitive and based on completed courses and grade point average (GPA). Students will be enrolled as degree students at PGCC and Frostburg State University (FSU) and begin to take FSU online courses during the Nursing Program at PGCC. Please note, a student must have approval from Ms. Stubbs at PGCC before being registered for the next course in the program at Frostburg State University until they graduate with their A. S. Degree. Once the Associate of Science Degree (A.S.) is awarded at PGCC, students must take and pass the nursing licensure exam, the NCLEX-RN, and then continue coursework at FSU to complete the Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing (B.S.N.).

Program length is <u>9 terms, including winter and summer sessions</u>, and it takes approximately 2 ½ years to complete.

PGCC courses will be held at the Prince George's Community College campus; <u>FSU courses will be taken as online</u> <u>courses</u>.

Two degrees will be awarded: A.S. from PGCC and B.S.N. from FSU (where a minimum of **30 credits** will be required from FSU to graduate).

Advisors will be available from both PGCC and FSU. Financial aid will be arranged through Frostburg State University Office of Financial Aid.

II. Program Admission Requirements

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- A. Admission to the PGCC Nursing Program
- B. Selective process based on courses completed, GPA, and TEAS score
- C. Completion of PGCC Nursing Program prerequisite courses (with a 3.0 GPA or higher)
- D. Additional required courses (completed by the start of the first nursing course) with a C or better:
 - 4 credits (must include a lab)
 - Statistics (MAT 1140)Nutrition (NTR 1010)

Chemistry (CHM 1010)

III. ATB Program Progression

Students must remain in Prince George's Community College's Nursing Program to continue in the ATB Option. Students are expected to complete the sequence of study as outlined in the PGCC - FSU ATB curriculum plan. Students must successfully pass the NCLEX-RN to complete the remaining FSU courses.

IV. General Application Procedures

Note: Students applying to the FSU ATB Option must also apply to the PGCC A.S. Degree Nursing Program. Admission to the FSU Option is contingent upon admission to PGCC's Nursing Program.

- 1. Apply online at https://www.frostburg.edu/admissions-and-cost/undergraduate/apply/transfer-applicants.php
- 2. Contact the FSU Department of Nursing, at nursing@frostburg.edu, to request an application fee waiver code. When prompted for payment, enter fee waiver code.
- 3. Have official transcripts from all previously attended colleges/universities sent to FSU Admissions.
- 4. FSU Admissions Office will review file and send to the FSU Nursing Department.
- 5. PGCC and FSU Nursing Departments will review for acceptance into the ATB option.
- 6. Student will be notified by email with admission decision.
