

IMMUNIZATION DOCUMENTATION POLICY

Frostburg State University requires all students to be immunized or show proof of immunity for rubeola, rubella, diphtheria, tetanus and mumps and to have documentation of these immunizations on file in the student health center. If a student was born before 1957, documentation for rubeola, rubella and mumps is not necessary.

Pursuant to MD Code Ann. S18-102(b), students who reside in the University residence halls are required to show evidence of the meningococcal vaccination or indicate in writing that they have waived that immunization. Students must provide documentation of vaccination or sign a waiver prior to occupying a room in the residence halls.

If students do not have immunization records on file in the student health center by advanced registration for the following semester, they are prohibited from pre-registering until records are complete at the student health center.
