

EARLY ADMISSION AND CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT

Early admission may be granted to a high school student who has demonstrated superior scholarship, as evidenced by his or her high school record and performance on the SAT. It is assumed that the student will have completed all requirements of the college-preparatory program outlined previously, except for the fourth unit in English, by the completion of the junior year in high school.

Frostburg State University will also allow such students to enroll in its undergraduate classes concurrently with their enrollment in high school as a non-degree student.
