 - ✓ Profile will be online version only (budgetary situations at University)
 - Launched beginning of March
 - Mid-February
 - Email will be going out
 - Postcard going out to entire constituent base notifying them of Profile and asking them update their email address
 - ✓ Students are moving in as we speak (began January 20)
 - ✓ Testing happening
 - Employees and students being tested every week
 - Half of population will be tested every other week. On testing weeks, individuals will be tested twice that week
 - ✓ Link to COVID information:
 - ✓ Classes start on Monday, 1/25
 - ✓ Classes offered in a blended or fully online format
 - ✓ FSU not on priority list for vaccine
 - USM trying to make faculty/staff a higher priority since they are working with students

 - √ Acceptances and deposits are running ahead
 - ✓ Winter intersession up 14%
 - ✓ New Director of Admissions hired over winter break (started early January)

 - Current goal is \$25million
 - As of 1/21, raised \$13million
 - This fiscal year: goal \$2.75millin, raised \$1.3million
 - Hoping to publicly launch the campaign this spring
 - End date is not set. Gift officers are struggling to meet with donors because of COVID.
