Dear Physician,

In order to administer allergy injections to your patient with the highest degree of safety, we ask that in addition to your regular instruction sheets, you complete and sign the attached form and return it to us. We would like to acquaint you with our facility staff and resuscitative equipment that we have available.

Personnel:

- We are a Nurse Practitioner directed clinic staffed by two full time Nurse Practitioners and two RNs. Our nursing staff is certified in Basic Life Support (BLS).

Our resuscitative equipment includes:

- Ambu Bag, mask and oral airway
- Oxygen delivery by nasal cannula, mask or non-rebreather mask
- Aqueous epinephrine HCL 1:1000
- Diphenhydramine (oral and injectable)
- Stethoscope and sphygmomanometer
- Nebulizer Treatments with Albuterol
- Pulse Oximeter
- AED

Not Available at Brady Health Center:

- We are not equipped to administer intravenous fluids, injectable steroids, or vasopressor medications.
- We do not have ECG monitoring capabilities.

Emergency Facilities and Responders:

- Frostburg is served by the Allegany County Emergency Management System.
- We are 20 minutes from the nearest emergency room.

If our facility capabilities meet your approval, please sign the attached form and return it to our center. *We cannot administer allergy injections to your patients until it is received.*
