

## Clues for Muhammad Ali

1. Born January 17, 1941 in Louisville, Kentucky and was given the nickname GG by his family.
2. He had his bike stolen at the age of 13 which caused him to meet Officer Martin who trained him in his gym.
3. His training schedule consisted of running alongside a moving bus and dodging stones thrown at him by his brother Rudy.
4. Later he trained with Fred Stoner and he kept telling himself "Don't quit, suffer now and live your life a champion".
5. Won a gold medal in the 1960 Olympics and in his career won 56 out of 61 fights.
6. Known as the People's Champion because he fought for people who were treated unfairly because of the color of their skin or religious beliefs.
7. Wins world championship February 25, 1964 and again in May 1965 by defeating Sonny Liston.
8. Developed a spiritual connection with Islam and became a Muslim in the 1960's which later helped him fight Parkinson's.
9. In 1964 changed his name from Cassius Clay.
10. Retired from boxing in 1981. Continued to build his legacy as a humanitarian and social activist until his death in 2016.
