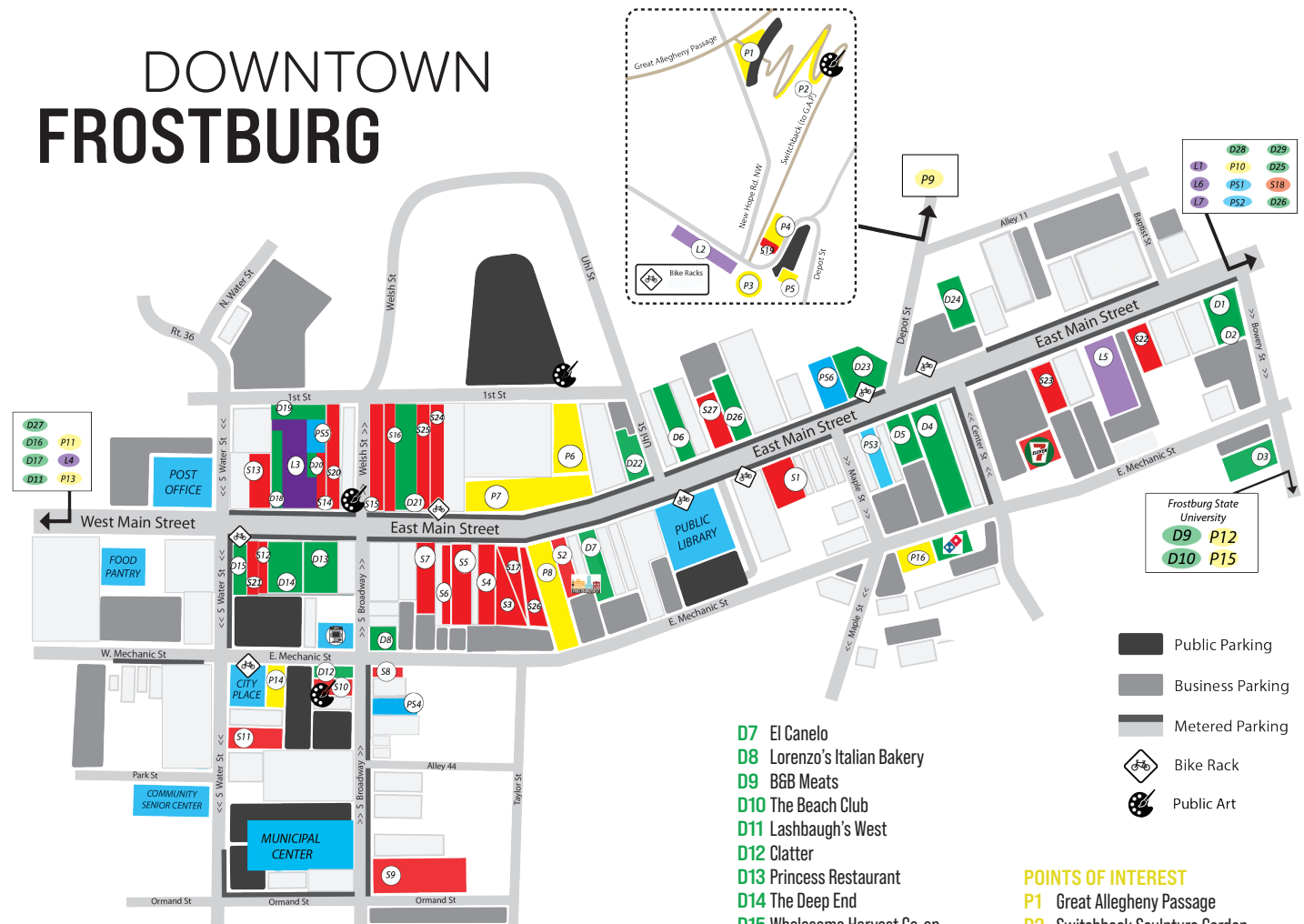
There's so much to explore

There's so much to explore in historic Frostburg, Maryland's Mountain City. Visit beautiful and well-maintained green spaces including **Hoffman Hollow Park** (Hoffman Hollow Rd), **Glendening Park** (Espy Ave), and the **Frostburg Dog Park** (100 Willow Dr). Visitors can enjoy the **Switchback Sculpture Garden** on the way up to the **Frostburg Depot** to watch the **Western Maryland Scenic Railroad** train roll in, or, spend the day hiking and biking on the **Great Allegheny Passage**! Be sure to check out **Tracks & Yaks** for a unique rail-biking and kayak rental experience.

DROP BY the **Thrasher Carriage Museum** (19 Depot St), a renovated warehouse hosting one of the largest collections of horse-drawn carriages in the country, or wander up Main Street to visit the **Frostburg Museum's** (50 E Main) collection of local history, oddities, and genealogy. While on Main Street, catch a movie or concert at the historic **Palace Theatre** (31 E Main).

LEARN MORE about conservation and preservation of local flora and Appalachian beauty at the **Evergreen Heritage Center** (15613 Trimble Rd). Then, be sure to explore the campus of **Frostburg State University** (101 Braddock Rd), where visitors will find an arboretum, planetarium, discovery center, music, theatre, and more.

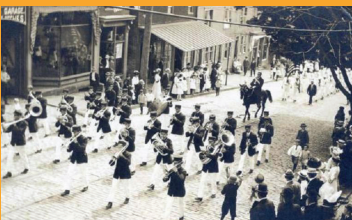

Frostburg is the second incorporated city in Allegany County, growing from an Appalachian mining town into a charming mountain retreat. Founded by the Frost family in 1812, the city of Frostburg owes its beginnings to westward expansion and the construction of the first National Road. Visit the **Braddock Stone**, one of America's oldest road signs, and the **Frost Family Gravesite** near the Frostburg Museum to trace the city's history to its roots. Head to Frostburg State University's campus where the **Brownsville Memorial** recognizes the lasting impact of Brownsville/Park Avenue, a community of freed and formerly enslaved people which once existed where the campus now stands. Today, Frostburg is home to over 8,000 people and supports small, locally owned businesses preserving Frostburg's rich and diverse heritage by giving new life to traditions passed down through the generations.

What began as a gateway to the west has become a destination for outdoor recreation and the arts, earning the Frostburg city motto: **"IT'S JUST COOLER HERE!"**

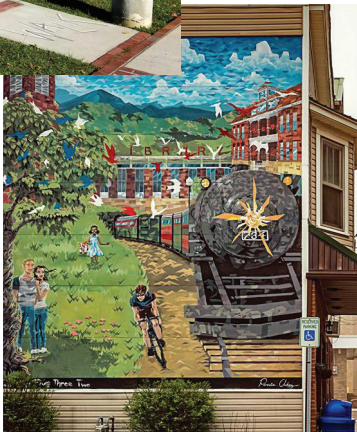

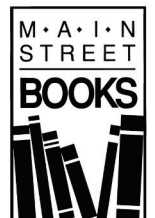
