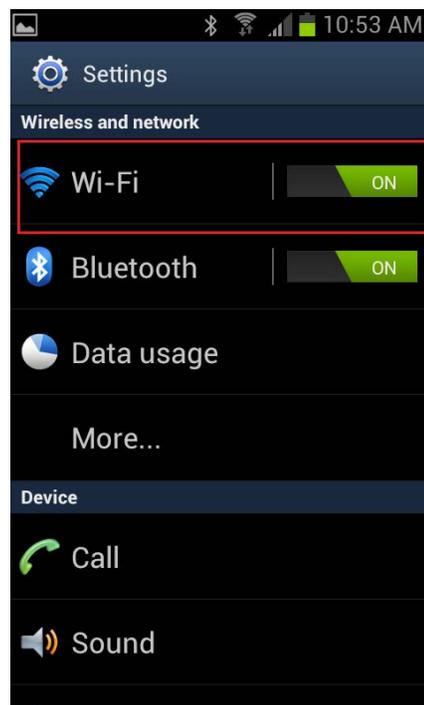
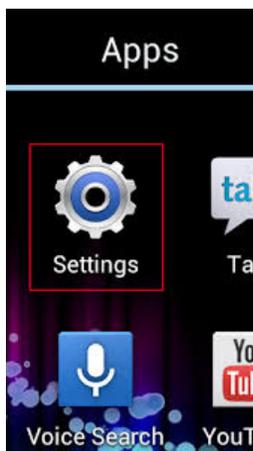


# Wireless Configuration for Android Mobile devices

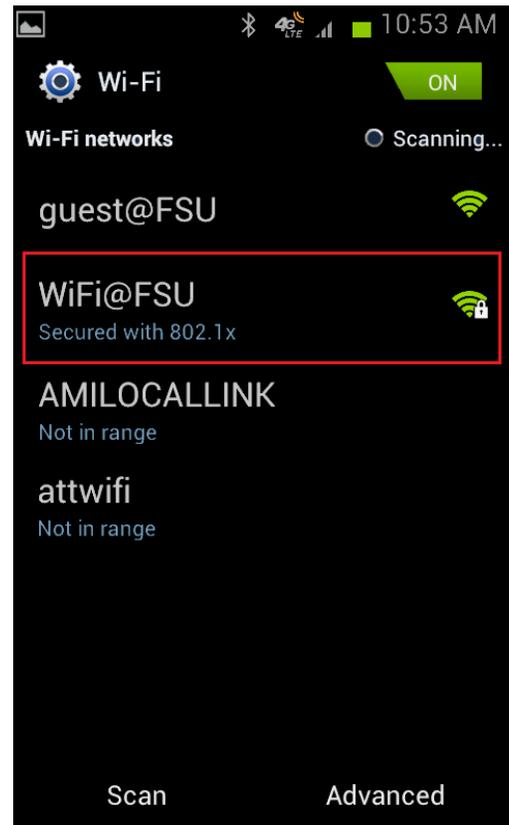
Frostburg State University offers wireless service to all employees and students which can be accessed almost anywhere on campus.

## Getting Started

1. Click the **Settings** icon, then select **Wi-Fi**



2. Select the **WiFi@FSU** wireless network



3. For the **EAP** method

select **PEAP**

In the **Phase 2 authentication** field

select **MSCHAPV2**.

For the **CA certificate** select

None, Unspecified, or Do not validate

In the **Identity** field

type your **FSU username**

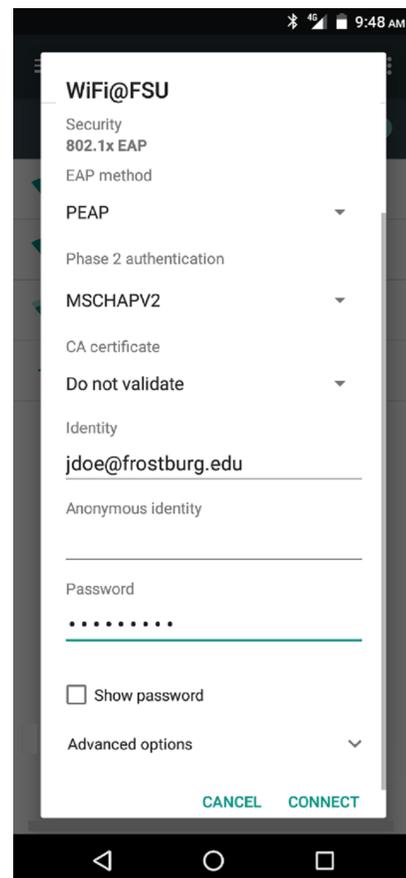
(e.g. [jdoe@frostburg.edu](mailto:jdoe@frostburg.edu))

Leave the Anonymous identity field blank

In the in **Password** field

type your **FSU password**

Then click **Connect**.



4. You should now be connected and online using **WiFi@FSU**.

You should not need to enter your credentials on subsequent connections to **WiFi@FSU**. Your Android device should be configured to automatically connect to this network in the future. If you aren't automatically connected, choose **Settings** and click the **WiFi@FSU** wireless to connect.

**\*\*\*IMPORTANT NOTE\*\*\***

When you change your FSU password don't forget to change it on all your mobile devices! You can do this by opening the **Wi-Fi Settings**, clicking on **WiFi@FSU** and selecting **Forget**. You can then reconnect with the new password.

If you do not do this after a password change, your device will continue trying to connect with the old password and cause your account to become locked out.
