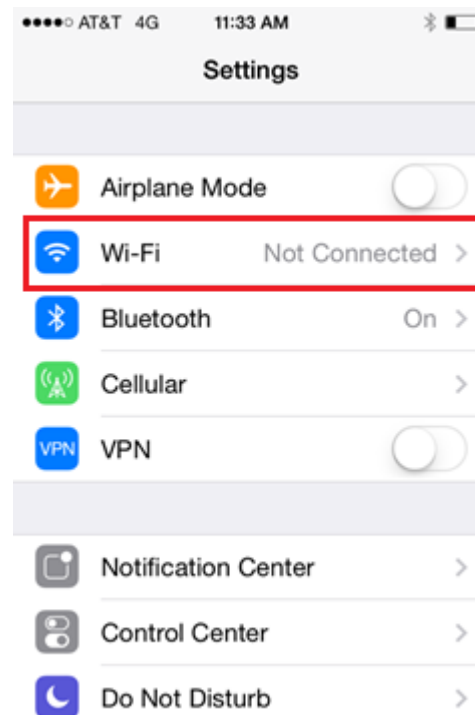


# Wireless Configuration for Apple Mobile devices

Frostburg State University offers wireless service to all employees and students which can be accessed almost anywhere on campus.

## Getting Started

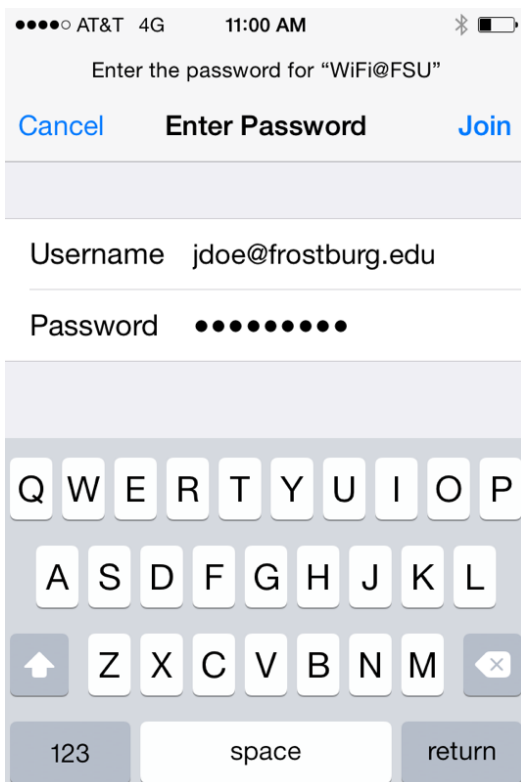
1. Click the **Settings** icon, then select **Wi-Fi**



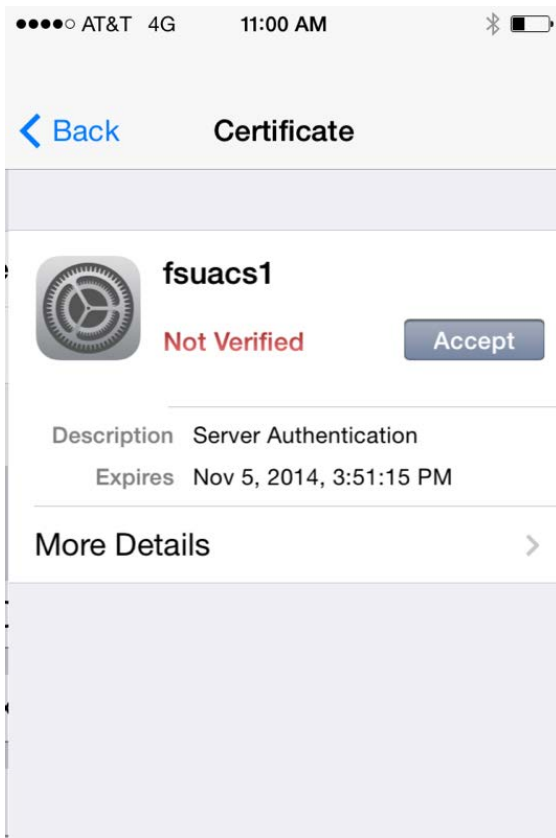
2. Select the **WiFi@FSU** wireless network



3. You will be prompted to enter credentials, type your **FSU username** and **password** (username in the format [jdoe@frostburg.edu](mailto:jdoe@frostburg.edu)), then click **Join**




4. You will be prompted to verify the FSU **Certificate**, click **Accept**



5. You should now be connected and online using **WiFi@FSU**.

You should not need to enter your credentials on subsequent connections to **WiFi@FSU**. Your Apple device should be configured to automatically connect to this network in the future. If you aren't automatically connected, choose **Settings** and click the **WiFi@FSU** wireless to connect.

**\*\*\*IMPORTANT NOTE\*\*\***

When you change your FSU password don't forget to change it on all your mobile devices! You can do this by opening the **Wi-Fi Settings**, clicking on the  next to **WiFi@FSU**, and selecting **Forget this Network**. You can then reconnect with the new password.

If you do not do this after a password change, your device will continue trying to connect with the old password and cause your account to become locked out.
