

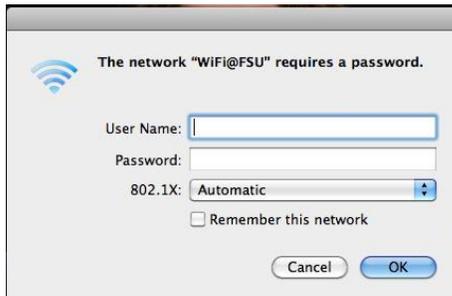
Wireless Configuration for Mac OS X

Frostburg State University offers wireless service to all employees and students which can be accessed almost anywhere on campus.

Getting Started

These instructions assume you have a computer running Mac OS X and an installed wireless network interface card (NIC) which supports WPA2 encryption.

1. Click **the Airport icon** in the Finder and select **WiFi@FSU**.
2. You will be prompted to enter your credentials, type your **FSU username** and **password**, click **OK**:



3. You should now be connected and online using **WiFi@FSU**. You should not need to enter your credentials on subsequent connections to **WiFi@FSU**. Your Mac should be configured to automatically connect to this network in the future. If you aren't automatically connected, choose the **WiFi@FSU** network from the wireless drop-down to connect
