Getting Started

These instructions assume you have a computer running Mac OS X and an installed wireless network interface card (NIC) which supports WPA2 encryption.

- 1. Click the Airport icon in the Finder and select WiFi@FSU.
- You will be prompted to enter your credentials, type your
