

Adding URL Links to LinkedIn Learning Courses in Canvas

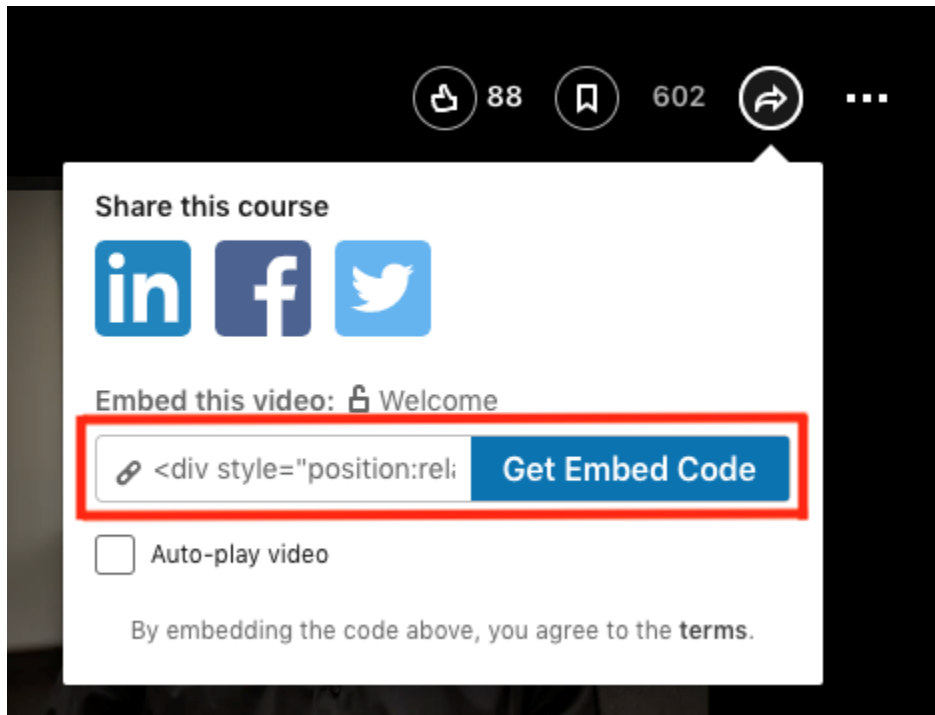
Option 1: Add the LinkedIn Learning course URL to your Canvas course

Copy the URL link to the LinkedIn Learning course directly from your browser. You can then [add a hyperlink onto a Page](#) in your Canvas course or [include it as a link in a Module](#) or Assignment.

Option 2: Embedding LinkedIn Learning Videos

Note: LinkedIn Learning allows users to embed only 5 videos per month. If you have used all your embeds for the month, it is recommended to give students a link to the course and a list of which videos to watch.

1. Login to [LinkedIn Learning](#) and select the video you would like to share.
2. Click on the "**Share**" icon (the right-facing arrow button)
3. Click on "Get Embed Code" to copy the code for embedding the video directly into your Canvas course.



4. Go to the page in your Canvas course where you want to include the video.
5. Click "Edit."
6. **To embed a link to a video** (make it appear directly on the page), click on the place you want to add the video and click on "Insert/edit media" button and then the Embed tab. Paste the embed code there and then click "OK."

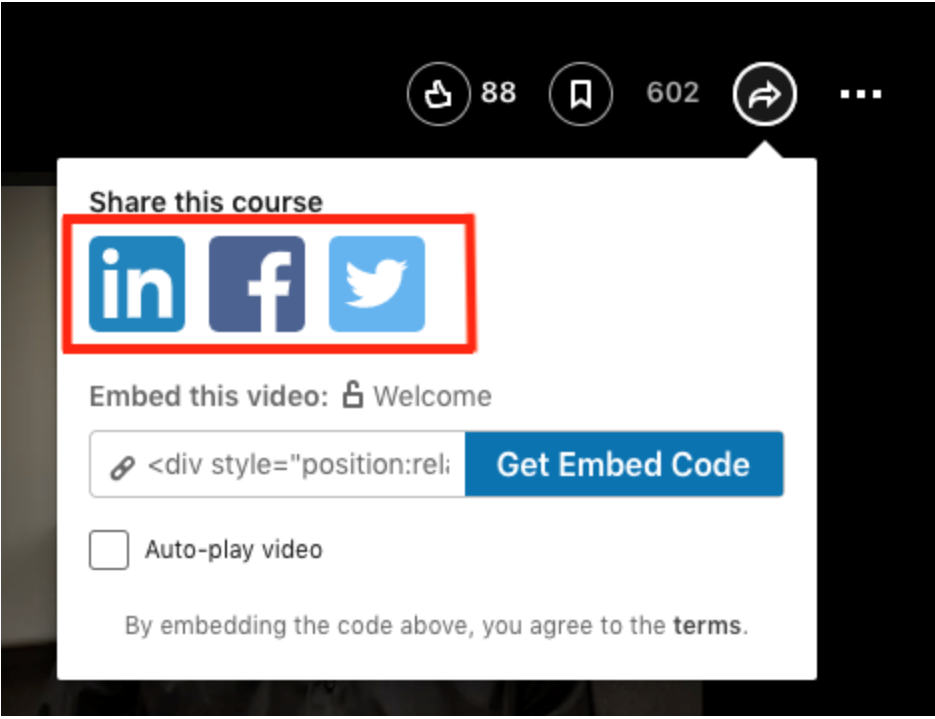
