CARES Act Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF)

Amended Interim Report Through June 30, 2020

As of June 30, 2020 Frostburg State University received 801 applications from the 4,005 eligible students and acted on 703 applications, awarding 511 requests for emergency funds, totaling \$615,223.64. Many of the outstanding applications are on hold pending further documentation from the student.

Graduate students received 10 awards totaling \$12,673.00, with an average of \$1,267.30 awarded per student while undergraduate students received 501 awards totaling \$602,550.64 averaging \$1,202.69 per student.

Denied applications totaled 186, with 40 denied due to the ineligibility of the applicant to receive HEERF awards; (7 were ineligible because they are not citizens or permanent residents, 29 were ineligible due to being fully online program students, 7 were non-degree student) and 146 were denied because the applicant was seeking funds for expenses beyond the parameters established by the Committee or by HEERF. The overall applications funded percentage was 73.7%.
